

# Rhonda Au Scholarship Award

## History of the Award

Rhonda Au was a highly motivated and dedicated student. In her sophomore year, it was discovered that she had a brain tumor. After treatment, she died in 1974. Upon her death, the division faculty started a fund to provide a scholarship for students majoring in Exercise & Sports Science in memory of Rhonda Au. Since 1974, the Division and the Au Family have donated to this fund.

## **Qualifications**

1. Be a top Exercise and Sports Science Major who exemplifies the standards, commitments, and attitudes of Rhonda Au.
2. Must have at least junior standing and have completed (2) semesters at BYU-Hawaii.
3. Must have taken a minimum of two core classes not inclusive of Sport Fundamental Classes.
4. Must have a minimum of a 3.0 cumulative GPA.
5. Demonstrate professional service and leadership by participating in either university, Division or community programs, activities or projects.
6. The final selection will be based upon the candidate's GPA, goals, professional service and leadership, and attitude.

## **Application Criteria**

Students must provide the following:

1. Completed TYPEWRITTEN application form.
2. Resume with the following information:
  - a. Personal background
  - b. Goals in Exercise and Sport Science
  - c. Personal and Family Values
  - d. Family Background
3. Current Photo (non-returnable)
4. Three (3) Letters of Recommendation, one at least from an Exercise and Sport Science faculty
5. Official transcript of all courses taken thus far.

The Rhonda Au Scholarship for Winter Semester 2015-2016 will be \$2,550 spread out over Winter & Spring Semesters (\$1,275 per semester). Awarded scholarship funds may not be deferred to a future semester or accumulated into one semester.
